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


Principal's Message

## LYNX Parent Activities Committee (PAC)

We invite you to please join our next Parent Action Committee (PAC) Annual General Meeting on Tuesday, **September 23<sup>rd</sup> at 7:30pm via zoom**. We will need to elect our new Board of Directors and are looking to still fill the positions of Chair and Treasurer.

#### Chair

Function: to act as chairperson of all Council meetings and oversee all Council activities.

Responsibilities: Preparation of agenda for Parent Advisory Council meetings; To act as cheque signing authority on the Parent Advisory Council bank accounts; To represent the Council at any Official function; To ensure that all Council business meets the objectives in our By-laws; To serve as an ex-officio member of all committees; To complete all required reports; To ensure continuity by meeting with past Chairs when necessary; To approve any minor expenditures up to \$50.00 without approval from Officers; To ensure any expenditure over \$50.00 has approval from the Officers by way of motion; To cast a deciding vote in the case of a tie.

#### **Treasurer**

Function: to account, monitor, and represent all financial transactions of the Parent Advisory Council.

Responsibilities: To establish a bank chequing account for the control of all Council funds; To act as one of the cheque signing authorities for the Council; To maintain an accurate accounting of all finances of Council; To receive and deposit all revenue collected on behalf of Council; To pay all expenditures as directed by the Chair and/or Officers; To provide a financial report to Council at all regular meetings; To provide an audited financial statement at the Annual General Meeting in October of every year, if an audit has been requested by the Board of Third Academy International Ltd.

Function: to help support other Council members and assist in endeavors of the Council in accordance with the philosophy statement.
